**GARBAGE COLLECTION**

Garbage pickup is every non-holiday Monday (see attached calendar). Each household in New Glarus is required to have an automated garbage cart. To report problems with your cart please contact *Pellitteri Waste Systems* for assistance. The best placement for the cart is at the end of the driveway or on the grass within two (2) feet of the street. Place your cart with the arrows on the lid of the cart pointing towards the street. The garbage and recycling carts should be placed together, with at least four (4) feet between them. Be sure the area where the carts are placed are away from obstructions like mailboxes, trees, cars. **Please do not place carts in the street or on top of or behind snow banks.**

**RECYCLING COLLECTION**

Recycling pickup will be every *other* week on Monday (see attached calendar). *Pellitteri Waste Systems* will utilize your green recycling cart for pick-up. To report problems with your cart please contact *Pellitteri Waste Systems* for assistance. The lid on the cart illustrates correct placement of the cart at your curb.

Trash carts and blue recycling carts are the property of *Pellitteri Waste Systems* and the green recycling carts are the property of the Village of New Glarus. Please do not take the carts if you move. You are responsible for any missing carts or damages to the carts other than normal wear and tear.

**COLLECTION TIMES**

Items for collection shall be at the curb or near the street edge for collection by **7:00 a.m. on day of pickup [Monday] (including clean-up day)**. Pick-up times may vary from week to week. Trash and recycling carts are picked up at separate times during the day.

**RECYCLING**

With single-stream recycling you do not have to sort your recyclables. **All recycling must be in the cart, with lid closed.** Recyclable materials should be clean and kept dry. Any item left in the cart has been rejected and will have a ticket in the cart explaining why it was rejected.

**SPRING CLEAN-UP**

Spring Clean-Up Day will be held on **Monday, April 22 and Tuesday, April 23, 2024**. Please place your items at the curbside by **7 a.m. on Monday, April 22nd**. If volume is high, collection will continue into Tuesday, April 23<sup>rd</sup> for the areas the collectors were not able to get to on the 22<sup>nd</sup>. Please place small items in trash bags (50lbs. or less), not reusable containers or cardboard boxes. Accepted items include: furniture, household trash, dry carpet (rolled and tied for one-person to handle), swing sets (dismantled), **bagged** box springs and mattresses, bed frames, gas grills (no tanks), charcoal grills, small lawn mowers or snow blowers (gas and oil must be removed). **NOT accepted:** Cardboard, e-waste including televisions and computer monitors, yard waste, building materials, tires, pianos, lead acid batteries, 55-gallon drums, household pesticides, concrete or dirt, oil tanks and filters, vehicle engine blocks, paints and thinners, and large appliances.

**Large appliances** (*i.e. stoves, refrigerators, humidifiers, microwaves, etc.*) In order to have a large appliance picked up with the Spring Clean-up on **Monday, April 22, 2024**, please contact the Village Clerk's Office at 527-3677 as those will require the **purchase of an appliance sticker**. **Deadline to purchase an appliance sticker is 2:00pm Friday, April 19, 2024.** To dispose of large appliances at any other time of the year, please contact *Pellitteri Waste Systems* directly.

## E-WASTE

Wisconsin's electronics recycling law *prohibits the disposal* of various electronic devices such as: computers, computer monitors, printers, TVs, VCRs, DVD players and phones with video displays. Green County Landfill and/or Madison Area Rehabilitation Centers (608-273-3630) will accept electronic devices at a fee. ## BRUSH – YARDWASTE – LEAVES

**Brush and branches** for curbside pickup should be placed curbside by the *first day of each month from April through October for pickup within the 1<sup>st</sup> week of that month by the Village*. After October, brush must be dropped off at the brush pile on 2nd Street (north of 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue). Village residents can also drop off brush on the brush pile anytime. Brush is 1" to 6" in diameter. The Village does not take any wood or limbs larger than 6" in diameter.

**Yard Waste** must be composted or dropped off in the compost bunker located at the Village Garage at 93 – 1st Street anytime during the months of April-November. Only yard waste should be placed in the bunker. ***Yard waste will not be picked up curbside and should not be placed in the curb line for storage.***

**Leaf Pickup:** Only leaves will be picked up with the Leaf Vacuum (***yard waste cannot be vacuumed up***). The Village will perform this service as weather permits during October through November. Leaves need to be raked into the gutter for this service. Please do not mix leaves with yard waste or brush.

***Please Note: Bagged leaves, compost, and yard waste will not be picked up curbside.***

## BULK WASTE ITEMS

Bulk waste items can be disposed of at any time by calling *Pellitteri Waste Systems* at (800) 400-4285 and arranging the pickup or hauling directly to the Green County Landfill. ## MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS

**Batteries** Car batteries can be dropped off during normal business hours at: Alpine Auto Electric, Symdon Chrysler, Dodge, Jeep and Ram and Sugar River Power Center. Batteries shouldn't be crackend or leaking.

### Compact Fluorescent Bulbs (CFLs)

Accepted at New Glarus Ace Hardware for a fee.

### Tires

Accepted at Green County Landfill. For additional information, including fees, please call the Landfill at (608) 897-8605 or check the Village website at [www.newglarusvillage.com/residents/garbage-recycling](http://www.newglarusvillage.com/residents/garbage-recycling).

### Used Oil

Accepted at Green County Landfill for a fee.

### Oil Filters

Used oil filters and oil absorbents are banned for disposal into landfills. Oil filters that are properly drained may be brought to the Green County Landfill for a fee or a salvage yard for recycling. ### Smoke Detectors

Should be returned to manufacturer. These *cannot* be placed with garbage or recycling as they contain *toxic materials*.

### Medications

Prescription drug drop box located in the lobby at the **Police Department**. You may also contact Green County Health Department [<http://www.greencountyhealth.org> or 608-328-9390] for proper disposal. *Do not flush down the toilet or pour into drains.*

### Paint

Latex or water-based paint can be placed in your regular garbage cart (not recycling) provided the paint is completely dry and solid. Please place in a plastic bag. Can add clean cat litter to absorb paint until solid. Oil or lead-based paints should be disposed of at a hazardous waste site.

### Hazardous Waste Disposal

Accepted at Green County Landfill from May 1 – October 31. For information on the specific items accepted for drop-off contact the Green County Landfill at (608) 897-8605.

## COLLECTION INFORMATION

**RECYCLING Information** – All recyclables should be placed in your recycling cart

### EXPANDED *Paper* RECYCLING

- Cardboard (empty)
- Catalogs, magazines & phone books
- Cereal & cracker boxes (empty)
- Computer & office paper
- Envelopes & junk mail
- Holiday gift wrapping paper (no foils)
- Newspapers
- Paper cups (no plastic lids or straws)
- Paper egg cartons
- Paper grocery bags
- Paper milk and juice cartons or boxes
- Pizza boxes (no food or grease)
- Shredded paper (place in clear or transparent plastic bag and tie shut; a full bag should be the size of a basketball)

### RECYCLABLE *Plastic & Glass*

- All plastic bottles (no motor oils or gasoline)
- Plastic containers/cups #1-7
- Glass bottles & jars (clear, blue, brown or green translucent glass)

### RECYCLING *Tips*

- Containers containing food or liquids, construction waste or electronics CANNOT be placed in the recycling cart.
- Should you choose to bag recyclables you place into the cart, please use clear or transparent bags and leave open – do not tie or seal. Clear bags can be purchased at most grocery and hardware stores.
- Do not flatten or crush plastic or metal items. Do not place smaller items inside larger containers. All items should be loose and empty. Remove all food waste, plastic, Styrofoam and packing peanuts.
- Flatten cardboard boxes and cereal boxes to make room in the recycling cart. The lid on your cart should shut.
- Your recycling cart will not be picked up if it contains trash, yard waste or prohibited items, or if overloaded. ### RECYCLABLE *Metal*

- Aerosol cans (empty)
- Aluminum cans & aluminum pie plates
- Metal pots & pans
- Small metal appliances (toasters, blenders, etc.) – nothing larger than a basketball
- Small metal plumbing fixtures, faucets, valves
- Tin & steel cans

### NON-RECYCLABLE *Items:*

- **Batteries** (fire hazard – check [call2recycle.org](http://call2recycle.org))
- Brake rotors / drums
- Construction waste
- Electronics
- Frozen food or microwave dinner plates
- Glassware & ceramics
- Metal items heavier than 10 pounds
- Mirrors & windows
- Motor oil & gasoline containers
- Plastic film, wrap & Styrofoam
- **Propane tanks** (fire hazard – check [earth911.com](http://earth911.com))
- Recyclable containers containing liquids or food
- Misc.: Carpet, clothing, diapers, fishing line, food, hoses, ropes & shoes
